The First Aid at Work training course is a HSE approved course.

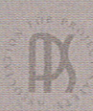
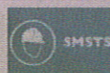
Course Duration: 3-Day

On completion of this First Aid at Work training course, delegates will be assessed in Practical and Theory aspects of First Aid to the **Health and Safety Executive Approved standard**. Successful completion of the First Aid at Work assessment will result in the award of a **'First Aid At Work' certificate** approved by the Health & Safety executive in line with Health and Safety First Aid Regulations 1981. The First Aid at Work certificate will be **valid for three years** and should be renewed by attending a two-day **First Aid at Work Refresher** course before the expiry date of the First Aid at Work certificate. Certificates are issued approximately 2 - 4 weeks after the completion date.
