Emergency First Aid at Work for Appointed Person training course is a Health & Safety Executive recommended, non-assessed course. This is the minimum level of First Aid training for the workplace, appropriate for low-risk environments or for those acting in the absence of a fully qualified First Aider.

Course Duration: 1-Day

-None assessment

-Annual refresher required



Successful candidates will be awarded a EFAW certificate and be able to provide basic first aid cover in the workplace in the absence of a fully qualified FAW (3 days qualified) First Aider.

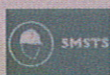
Emergency First Aid at Work Course Content:

To be able to provide basic life support delegates will receive training in a range of First Aid subjects, including:

- Aims and Principles of First Aid
- Action at an Emergency
- Basic Life Support
- Management of the Unconscious Casualty
- Assessment and treatment of a casualty who is wounded, bleeding or shocked
- Assessment and treatment of fractures, dislocations and soft tissue injuries
- Assessment and treatment of burns
